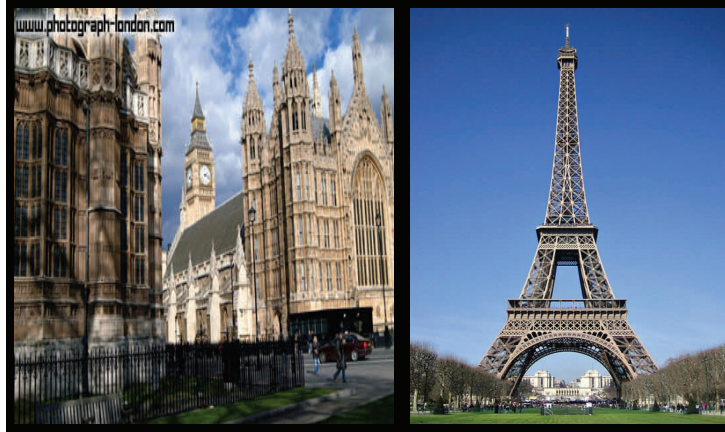

Program Information:

This program will explore some of the most significant work in the areas of Architecture, Urban Design, Preservation and Art both in London and Paris and their environs. While in London students will visit such sites as Westminster Abbey, Marble House, The National Art Museum, Trafalgar Square, and the Wren Churches. Day excursions to Dorset and Brighton are included. While in Paris, students will visit Notre Dame, The Louvre, the Champs Elysee, Montmartre, Chartres Cathedral and the Musee D'Orsay. An entire day excursion will be spent at Versailles.

Participants in this program should be able to walk for long periods of time.
