Program Information:

The students who participate in this program depart Charleston for Berlin, Germany the second week of May 2010 (approximately May 11, 2010) and will attend a four week intensive language course at the CDC Sprachenzentrum. In early June, the students will do a two month internship in a field of their choosing which will terminate in early August 2010. During the internship phase, the host organization generally provides free housing or a stipend from which students will pay for their own housing.
