## Program Information:

This summer program will be a twenty-five day immersion in the history, culture, politics, languages and geography of this unique African country. The first portion of the program takes place in Tangier, where students will be housed in a hotel in the heart of the city. During this time, students will attend formal classes and the afternoons and weekends will include guided excursions of Tangier's sites, including the medina Azila. The second part of the program is a guided tour of the Moroccan cities such as Casablanca, Marrakesh, Fez and Rabat. Students will spend one night in desert tents. Subject to cost and feasibility, in 2010 for the first time, the final part of the program will be a two to three night excursion to Andalusia in Spain to complete the student's understanding of historical Morocco during the 700 years that the Moorish Empire ruled this part of Spain.

Dr. Attafi is a Professor of French, originally from Tangier, Morocco. He has vast experience with study abroad programs, having directed the French summer study abroad program for over 10 years.

Dr. Parson is a Professor of political science and former Director of International Education and Programs. He lived in Uganda and Botswana a total of ten years and has traveled extensively on the African continent. He previously taught in the CofC summer program in France and in the spring semester program in Trujillo, Spain. Both Dr. Parson and Dr. Attafi have directed the summer program to Morocco the past several years.
