This program will offer the opportunity to study one semester in Buenos Aires, Argentina, and earn 12-15 hours of credit through the College of Charleston. Known as a dynamic urban cosmopolitan center of culture, business and modern life, Buenos Aires is the perfect setting for students desiring to hone their language skills and at the same time immerse themselves in the business and political culture of South America. Students will live in "residencias" with Argentine and other foreign students carefully selected to provide an enriching cultural and social experience.

The semester will coincide with the fall months in the southern hemisphere, an ideal season to do traveling, and to enjoy a period of intense cultural activity. The program includes several days of excursions through the north and west of Argentina, the Iguazu Falls, and through Uruguay. As classes will be conducted from Monday through Thursdays, students will have additional travel opportunities during the long weekends. Traveling to neighboring South American countries will be possible either during or after the semester.

Classes will be held at the University of Buenos Aires School of Law and Social Sciences, and taught by faculty who are carefully selected and approved by the College of Charleston. Students will have easy access to all university facilities on the main campus.

This program is designed mainly for students who are Spanish majors and minors interested in taking up to 12 hours of upper level Spanish, students majoring or minoring in Latin American and Caribbean Studies, or students interested in developing fluency in Spanish and maintaining normal progress toward graduation. Interested students must have completed at least one 300 level Spanish course.

## Program Costs:

The comprehensive program fee of **\$4,650 (estimated)** includes:

- Round trip airfare
- Housing and meals in residencias
- Hotel accommodations and 2 meals a day while on excursions
- All ground transportation while on excursions
- International Medical Insurance
- International Student ID Card

\***TUITION** is **NOT** included in the program fee. Students will pay their normal CofC tuition in addition to the program fee.
