Membership Agreement

1. To adhere to all rules and regulations posted and/or distributed to Association members regarding use of all sailboats.

To accept full financial responsibility for the incidental breakage and/or loss of equipment while using the sailing craft, and to accept full financial responsibility for the destruction of the sailing craft in my care if said loss is due to misuse or irresponsible handling in the judgment of the sailing director and the directors of the Association. I further understand that the Sailing Association carried hull and liability insurance with a deductible.
3. To hereby release and discharge the College of Charleston and each and all of their agents and employees from any liability whatever to the below signed resulting from or in any manner arising out of, any injury or damage which may be sustained by the below signed on account of his/her participation in the use of sailing craft issued by the College of Charleston Sailing Association to its members.

Sailing Association Rules



As an Association member, you agree to the following:

1. To use sailboats only during designated days and hours at which times the dock attendant is on duty.
Normal hours of operation:
Wednesday through Sunday - 10:00 am - 5:00 pm (6:00 pm during daylight savings time).
2. To pay a guest fee of \$5.00 per day per guest.
3. To abide by the directions of the dock attendant as to:
 - Sail combination for that day including reefing
 - Method of leaving and returning to the marina
 - Designated sailing areas. Note: Never sail beyond area bounded by Ft. Sumter and Cooper River Bridges.
4. To rig and unrig your assigned boat.
5. To dry all sails before storing if feasible
6. To properly secure your boat at the dock and insure that all lines are in proper order.
7. To clean your boat thoroughly inside and out and hose off deck hardware.
8. To report all malfunctions and /or damage to the dock attendant both before and after sailing.
9. To accept financial responsibility as detailed in the membership agreement.
10. To pay a fee of \$100.00 each time your boat is grounded.
