Qualifications:

- South Carolina resident
- Rising junior or senior majoring in accounting (or Master's Degree student) at a South Carolina college or university.
- GPA of no less than 3.25 overall (on a 4.0 scale).
- GPA in accounting no less than 3.5 (on a 4.0 scale).

Applications must be received complete with all attachments & postmarked by June 1, 2009 in order to be considered. Awards are decided in July for the fall semester, and checks will be distributed by August 15, 2009 payable to the school. Scholarship recipients will be recognized at the SCACPA Annual Summit and Member Meeting in November 2009. Amounts of scholarships usually range from \$500 to \$2,000. The number to be awarded each year depends upon the qualifications of the applicants and available funds.
