Bret Lott earned his BA at California State University and his MFA from the University of Massachusetts, Amherst. He joined the Department of English faculty at the College of Charleston in 1986 and was promoted to full Professor in 1997. In 2004, he left the College to become Editor and Director of *The Southern Review* and Professor of English at Louisiana State University. For Fall semester 2007, he will be returning to the College of Charleston as Professor of English and Writer-in-Residence. His other experience includes an affiliation with the Bennington College writing program, service as a faculty member and director of the Vermont College MFA Program in Writing, and service from 2001 to 2004 as Editor of the literary journal *Crazyhorse*. Professor Lott is the author of seven novels, the newest of which is *Ancient Highway*, to be published by Random House. Others are *A Song I Knew By Heart*, *The Hunt Club*, *Reed's Beach*, *Jewel*, *A Stranger's House* and *The Man Who Owned Vermont*. He also has published three story collections, two nonfiction books and many stories and essays. He has edited three anthologies and has had approximately 40 works published in anthologies and textbooks.
