Each year the MES Program provides some financial support for students who participate in field-related conferences, a vital component in the professional development of graduate students. MES students are encouraged to attend conferences in their discipline, and degree-seeking students in the MES Program are eligible to apply for travel funding. Available travel funding is awarded on a first come, first serve basis, with priority given to students who are presenting papers or participating in poster sessions.
