Bachelor's Essay Enrollment Instructions

This form is to be filled out by the student and is to be signed by the student, the faculty member with whom the student is working, and the chair of the department. If the student is enrolling in HONS 499, the Honors College Dean must sign the form instead of the department chair. After all signatures have been obtained, this form will be taken to the Registrar's Office where a section for the Bachelor's Essay will be created and the student will be enrolled in it. The student should keep a copy of the signed form, give a copy to his/her department, and also bring one to the Honors Center if the student is in the Honors College.

The absolute deadline to submit this form to the Registrar's Office is approximately six weeks after the start of the semester. However, students should have begun a dialogue and have a commitment from the professor or other individual with whom he or she will be working with the semester prior to the one that the Bachelor's Essay work begins. Some departments require that all Bachelor's Essays be approved before the end of the Spring Semester for Bachelor's Essays beginning in the Fall. Students should check with their individual departments about the regulations governing the Bachelor's Essay as these may vary from department to department.
