

### How To Graduate On Time With A BSBA (without concentration)

This graphic shows the course progression that a student needs to follow in order to graduate on time (end of 4th semester after admission to the School of Business and Economics). All arrows represent prerequisites. Vertical bars represent the semester in which courses are *normally* taken. Variations in semesters are permissible, as long as prerequisites are fulfilled. What this means, for example, is that if you have two semesters left and are taking MGMT 301 in the first of these two semesters, you will have to take DSCI 304 in the second of these two semesters, thus making it impossible to take MGMT 408 until a third semester (or summer session) after your current position.
